From Tokushima Awaodori Airport:

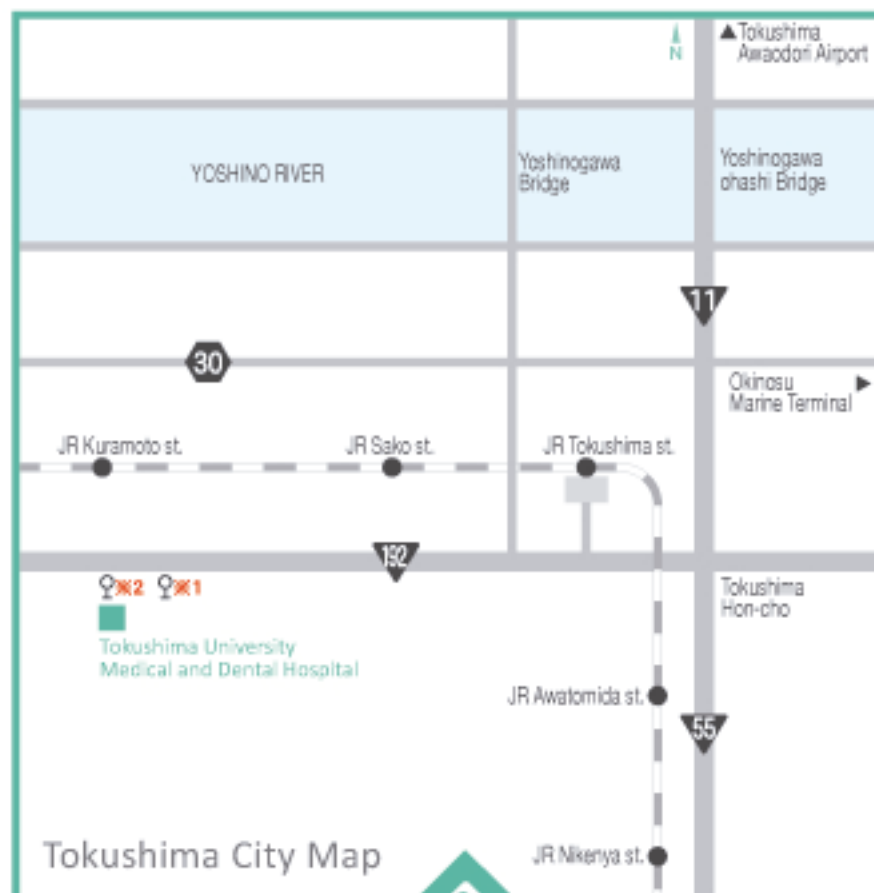
Take a taxi 30minutes (5000 JPY)
