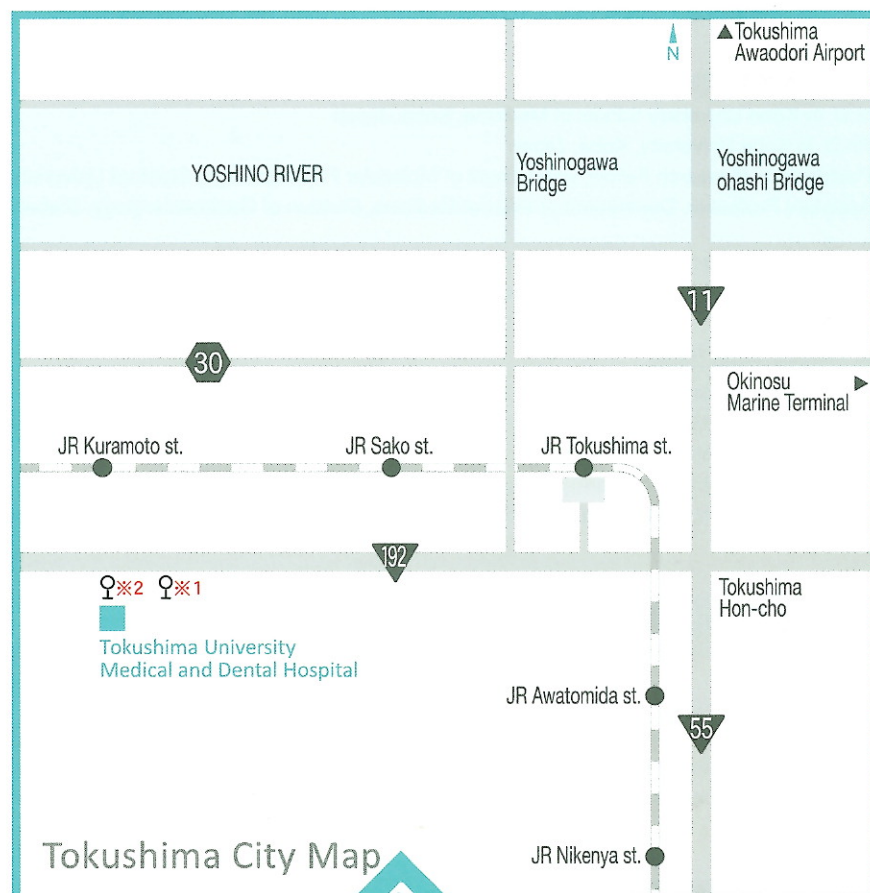


## Access

Five minutes walk



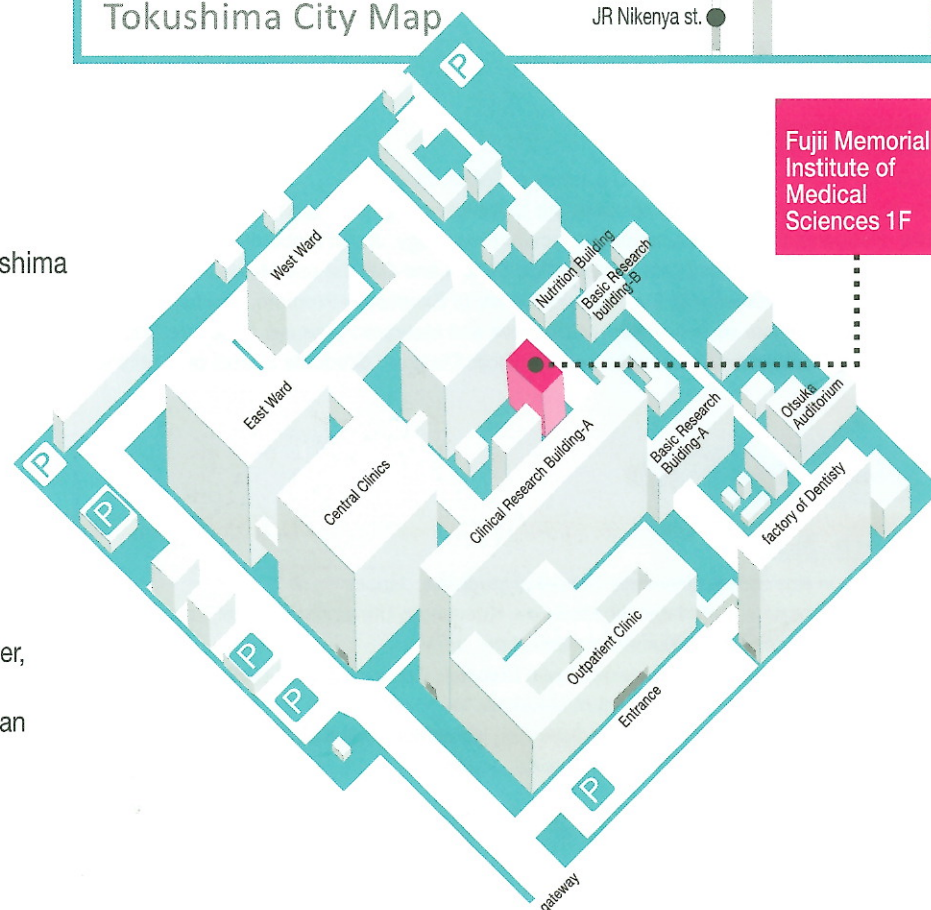
